PLAYGROUND RULES

Bells

- STOP playing when bell rings
- PUT AWAY any equipment you used
- WALK to your line or to class

Blacktop

- No chase or tag
- Games are open to all students
- No kicking playground balls
- Stick to school rules for each game

Equipment

- Do not sit on top of bars
- Do not throw bark
- No chasing or tagging games around equipment
- Leave area promptly when bell rings
- Supernova:
 - -Sit on when stopped -Maximum six students ride for one minute -Maximum of four students to spin ring
 - -Stand three feet away while it is spinning
- Minkar:

-Climb up blue climber, NEVER slide down -Do not sit on top of Minkar

• Rock Block:

-Stand three feet away if someone is on Spica -Stay on one minute and get back in line -Maximum of two students at one time

• Spider Web Structure: -Go down yellow slide

-Go up the metal corkscrew -No spinning on the bars

Fields

- Keep balls away from fences
- Games are open to all students
- No wrestling or tackling or aggressive play

General

- Stay on the playground unless you have permission
- Use the playground bathrooms and drinking fountains only

• All lunches and water bottles stay on cart when not being used

•No phones, cameras or personal electronic devices to be used on playground or field

> Safe and appropriate footwear should be worn daily

NO BULLYING

What are bullying behaviors?

- Actions or words that purposely hurt other people's feelings or body that continue after requests to stop.
- Negative behaviors that are repeated over and over.
- Behaviors that make the person feel like it cannot be stopped.

What can I do if I am being bullied?

- Never keep it a secret.
- I can tell an adult (teacher, recess supervisor, nurse, principal, parent).
- I can expect the behavior to stop. Make sure the principal knows if it does not stop.
- I can choose to play with supportive friends.
