Please read the following information regarding an exciting opportunity to sign your child up for a public library card through the San Diego Public Library system:

There are *many* benefits to your student having a public library card. Your child will be able to select from some fantastic juvenile fiction, non-fiction and audiobooks from the Encinitas library collection. These materials can be downloaded to school iPads so you never need to drive to the library! Also, overdue materials are not a concern with library ebooks and audiobooks - after the 14 day loan period expires, the book is automatically returned to the library. No worries!

We will be teaching participating students how to search and download county library materials. We will also be reminding students of our school policies and guidelines for the use of county library materials on their school iPad.

To sign up you **MUST** fill out the following two forms:

1. Library Card Application: this is the *standard public library card form*. (The “Acceptance of Responsibility” mainly pertains to people checking out hard copies of materials NOT downloading materials)
2. Internet/DVD and video Consent form: Also a standard form for guardians to complete for minor children. (Please note students should not be downloading these types of materials on their school iPads)
3. **For those students who already have library cards**, please write their library card number and their name at the top of the application. Please sign the Internet DVD and video consent form.

This is a tremendous, FREE opportunity for your student to access educational materials!

Please return all required forms back to your student’s teacher or library NO later than October 13th to allow your student to be included in the library training.
